Transfers

By road: The nearest airport is Lanseria International Airport (HLA), a 3-hour drive away, or O.R. Tambo International Airport (JNB), a 3½-hour drive away on good roads. By air: There are daily flights from Lanseria (HLA) to Marakele (1 hour), and 3 flights a week from the Sabi Sands (1½ hours). The airstrip is directly adjacent the park and a 10-minute drive from the Conservation Camps. Please enquire for helicopter transfers and charter flights.

Children

- Children of all ages are welcome at Marataba Conservation Camps.
- Conservation & Community Levy is complimentary for children under 2 years, and 50% of the adult rate for children 2-15 years.
- Cots are available for ages 0 – 2 years at no additional charge.
- Stretcher beds are available for ages 2 – 15 years, and the 50% child rate applies.
Note: stretcher beds and cots are limited across camps.
- While both camps are fenced, wildlife may enter the camp and children's safety remains the full responsibility of parents at all times.
- Explorers Camp, with large, lush lawns shaded with trees and a dedicated family tent, is very well suited to younger guests.
- The Star Camp Out is only suitable for children aged 12 years and older.

Terms & Conditions

- Rates are quoted in South African Rand (ZAR) and include VAT. Rates are reviewed quarterly and are subject to change.
- A minimum stay of 3 nights is required for all bookings, allowing 2 full days for guests to immerse themselves in the conservation experience.
- Upon enquiry, bookings will be held for 14 days after which they are either confirmed or released.
- A **20% refundable commitment fee** is required to confirm the booking (refundable only in the case of a COVID-related reason; see Refund Disclaimer below).
- Once confirmed the booking is held on a status of **'confirmed with commitment fee'** until any of the following becomes true:
 - The booking is cancelled in writing by the agent.
 - At 60 days prior to travel when the full payment is due. At this time, the booking status changes to **'confirmed with full-payment.'**
- Final payment is due 60 days prior to arrival. Any outstanding balance shall be required to be settled.
- All deposits, commitment fees and full payments are held in a separate call account and do not become part of the operational cash flow until the guest has stayed.
- The amount stated on the invoice is what must be received by Marataba Conservation Camps nett of bank charges / credit card fees.
- Resident rates will be honoured on a 14-day lead period; outside this time, they can be offered on request.**

Cancellations

- Cancellations must be received and acknowledged by Marataba Conservation Camps in writing.
- **'Confirmed with commitment fee'** OR **'confirmed with full-payment'**: In the event of any reservation being cancelled after Marataba Conservation Camps has issued a confirmation, subject to the Refund Disclaimer, the following cancellation fees will apply:
 - 'Confirmed with commitment': if cancelled between confirmation and 61 days prior to arrival, the 20% commitment fee is forfeited.
 - 'Confirmed with full-payment': if cancelled between 60 days prior to arrival, the full reservation value is forfeited.

REFUND DISCLAIMER

- Cancellations must be received and acknowledged by Marataba Conservation Camps in writing.
- Marataba Conservation Camps will allow any funds received to be utilised as a credit against future bookings to be scheduled within 24-months of the initial travel dates, if travel is cancelled with a commitment fee or 60 days or less prior to arrival due to a WHO-recognised pandemic, or some other reasonable event or development, directly impacting the guests' ability to travel (e.g. lockdown, no flights, guest not allowed to board a flight, guest falls ill due to a pandemic and unable to travel).
- In the event of a WHO-recognised pandemic, or some other event or development outside of their control, directly impacting the ability of Marataba Conservation Camps to meet its obligations with respect to the booking, all monies received, including the commitment fee, will be fully refunded (e.g. lockdown in RSA, government restrictions on trade).
- Any refund is given at the discretion of Marataba Conservation Camps management.
- All travellers are advised to take out fully comprehensive travel insurance with 'cancellation for no reason'. This insurance must be able to fully cover cancellation of travel fewer than 60 days prior to arrival.
